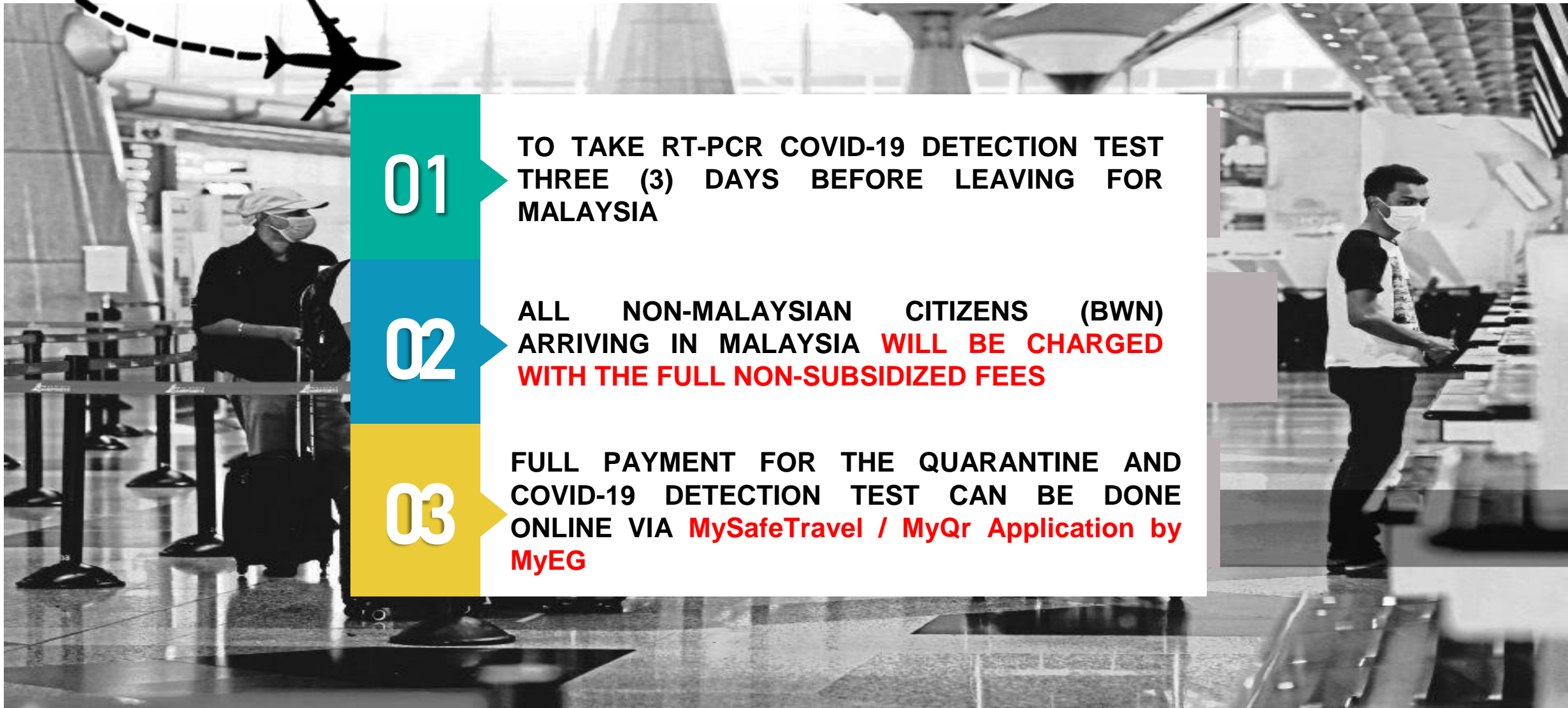
TO TAKE RT-PCR COVID-19 DETECTION TEST THREE (3) DAYS BEFORE LEAVING FOR MALAYSIA

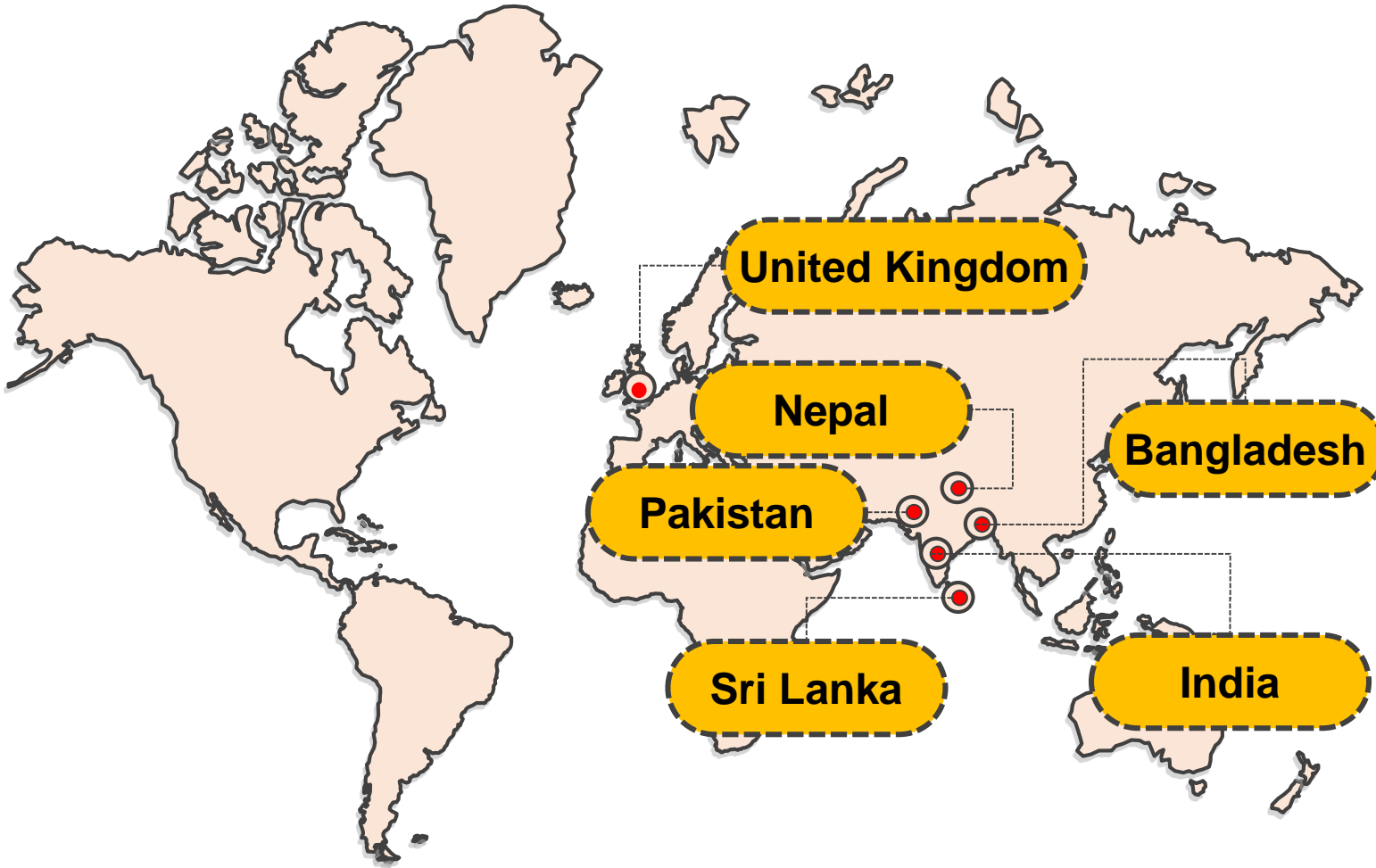

Malaysia Government has imposed a temporary entry ban on citizens of SIX (6) countries to curb the further spread of the COVID-19 pandemic.

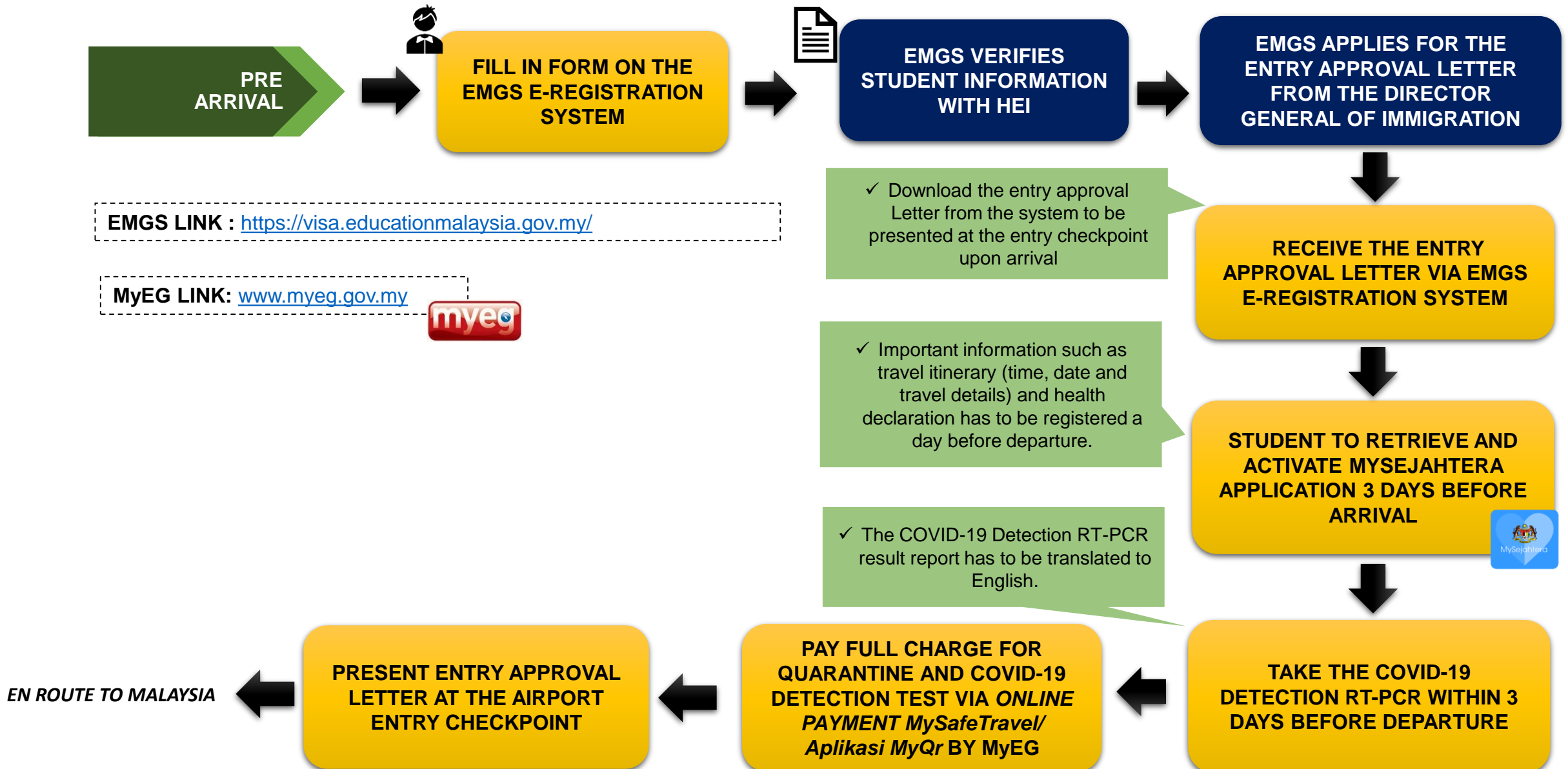

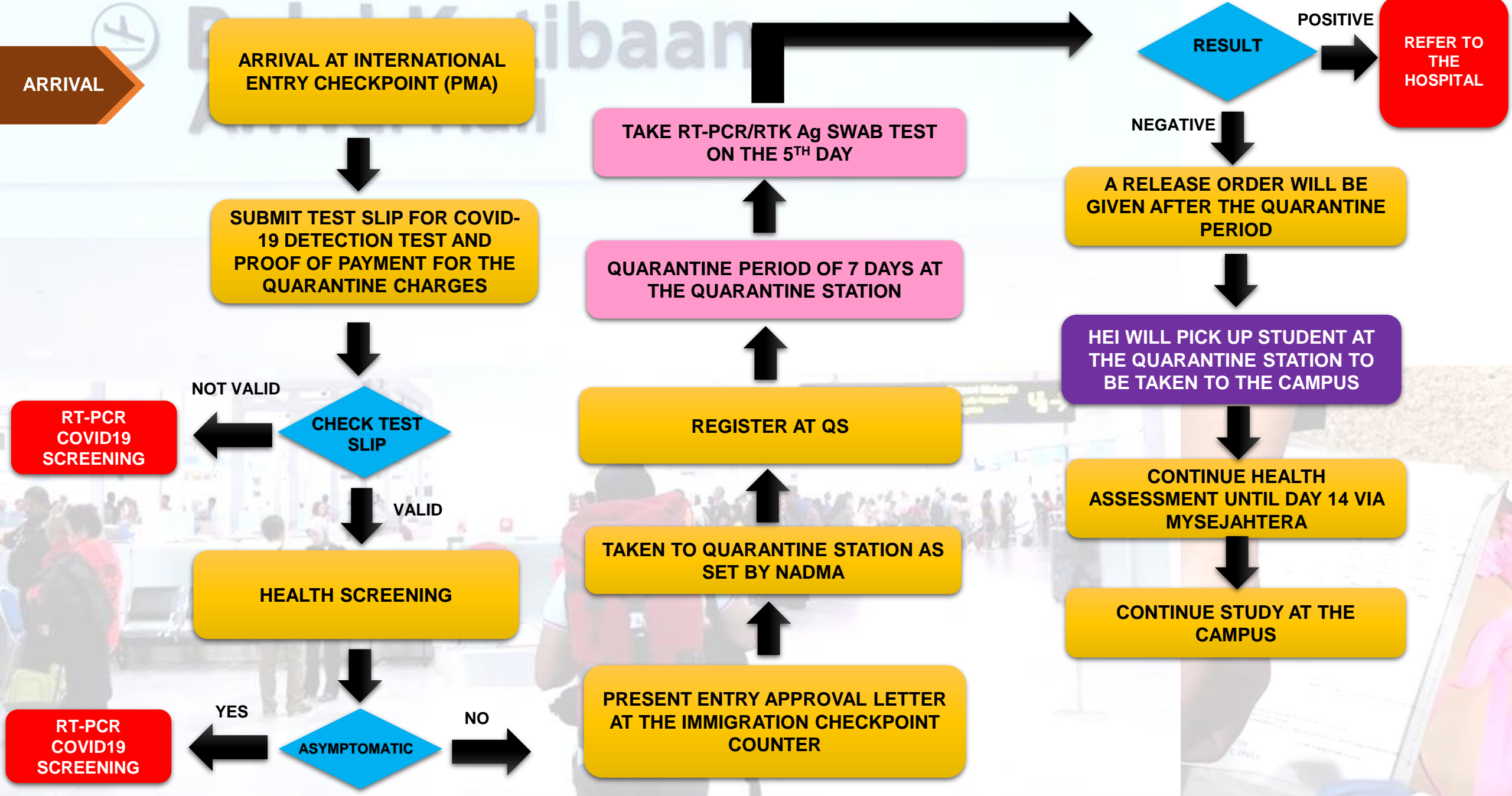
INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ENTRY PROCESS FLOWCHART



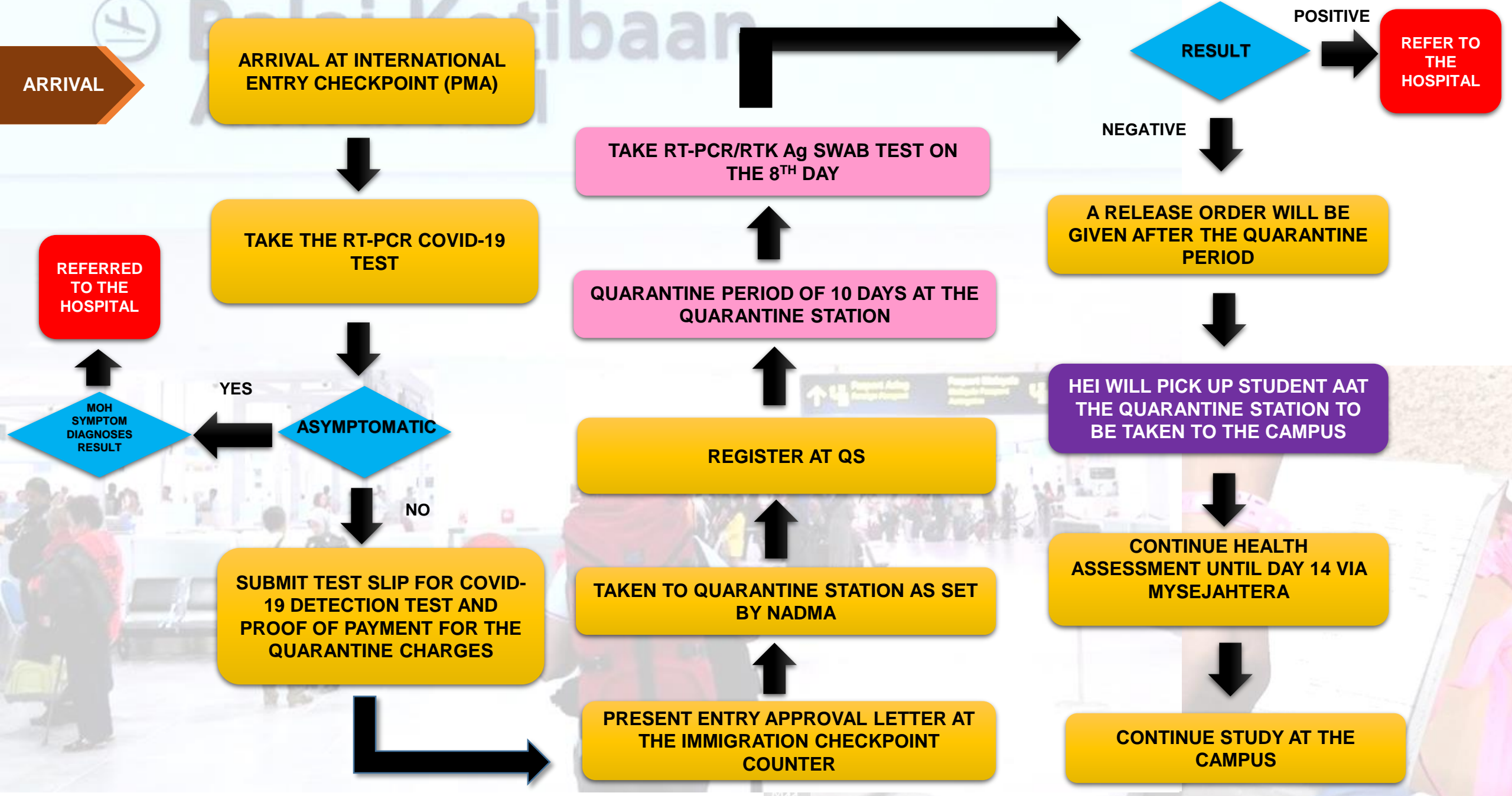

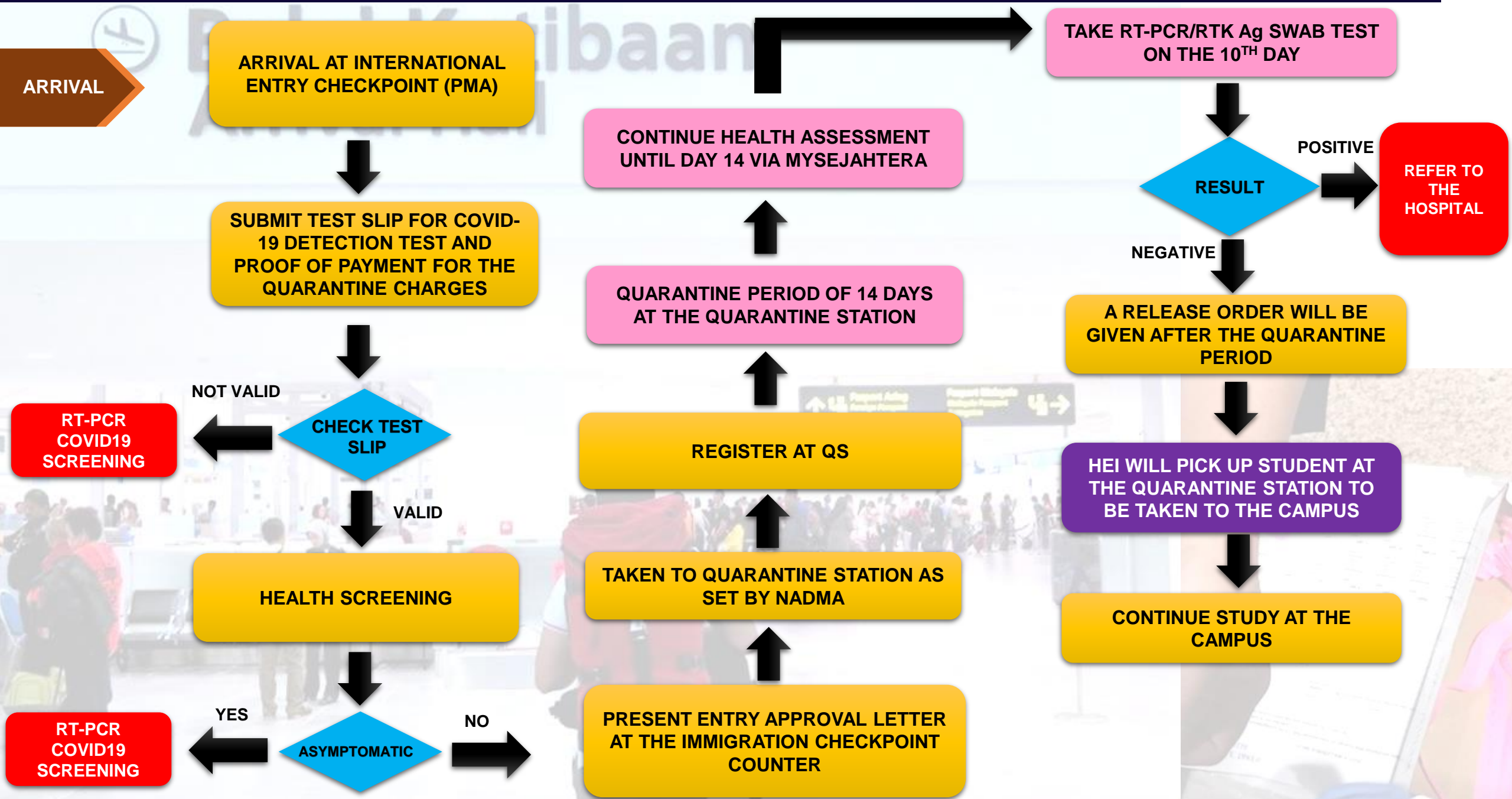
STUDENTS ENTERING MALAYSIA WITH THE RT-PCR REPORT

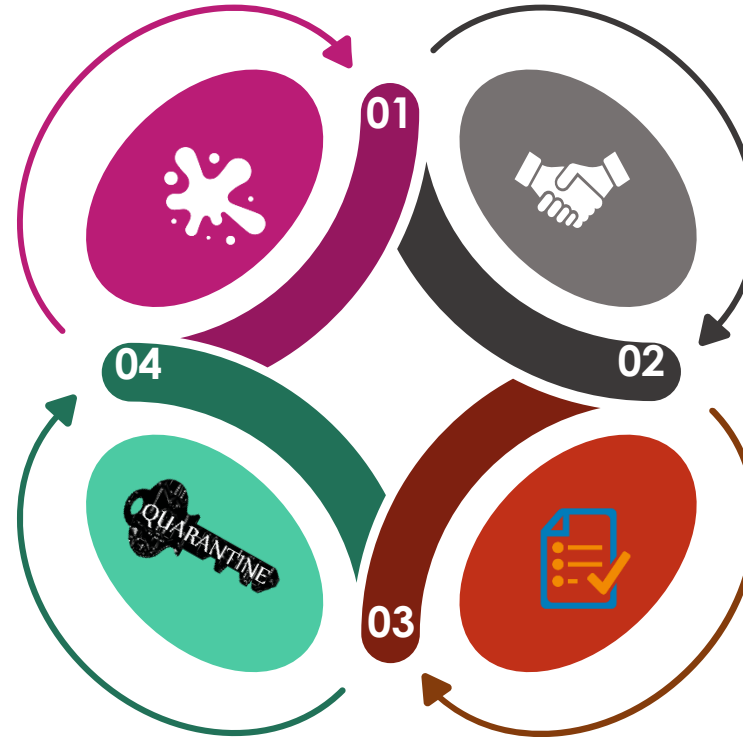

Arrange logistics to pick up student after the mandatory quarantine at the quarantine station to the campus

Verify student's information before EMGS forwards the application to IMI for approval

03

Inform student of the latest back-to-campus SOP in accordance to the orders, rules and guidelines set and updated by the Government from time to time and ensure student's adherence to the SOP

Pre Arrival

01

Obtain an Entry Approval letter from the Director-General of Immigration (DGI)

02

Download, activate and register personal details on the MySejahtera application.

03

Pay full charge for the quarantine and the COVID-19 screening test via online system which is the MYSAFETRAVEL/ application MYQR by MYEG

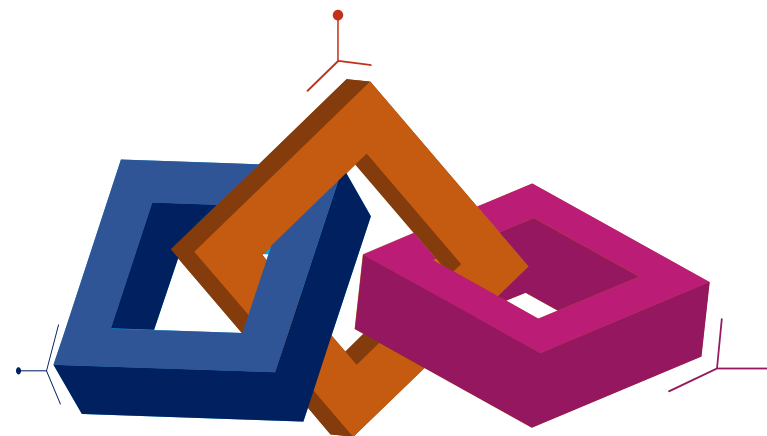
04

Take a RT-PCR COVID-19 screening test Three (3) days before departure to Malaysia.

Upon Arrival

01

Do health screening and take a COVID-19 detection test



Post Arrival

01

Register at the Quarantine Station

02

Be fully responsible for own belongings and luggage

03

Do own health assessment daily until day 14 via MySejahtera



EXIT PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS BACK TO ORIGIN COUNTRY

ANNOUNCEMENT : TO EXIT THE COUNTRY

01

WITH THE VALID STUDENT PASS, INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ARE ALLOWED TO EXIT THE COUNTRY UNCONDITIONALLY.

02

HOWEVER, TO ENTER THE COUNTRY AGAIN, THE STUDENTS MUST FOLLOW THE LATEST ENTRY PROCEDURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS BACK TO CAMPUS.

03

FOR THOSE FROM OUTSIDE SELANGOR AND NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER THE STATE WITHOUT PERMISSION, PLEASE REFER INTERSTATE TRAVEL PROCEDURE

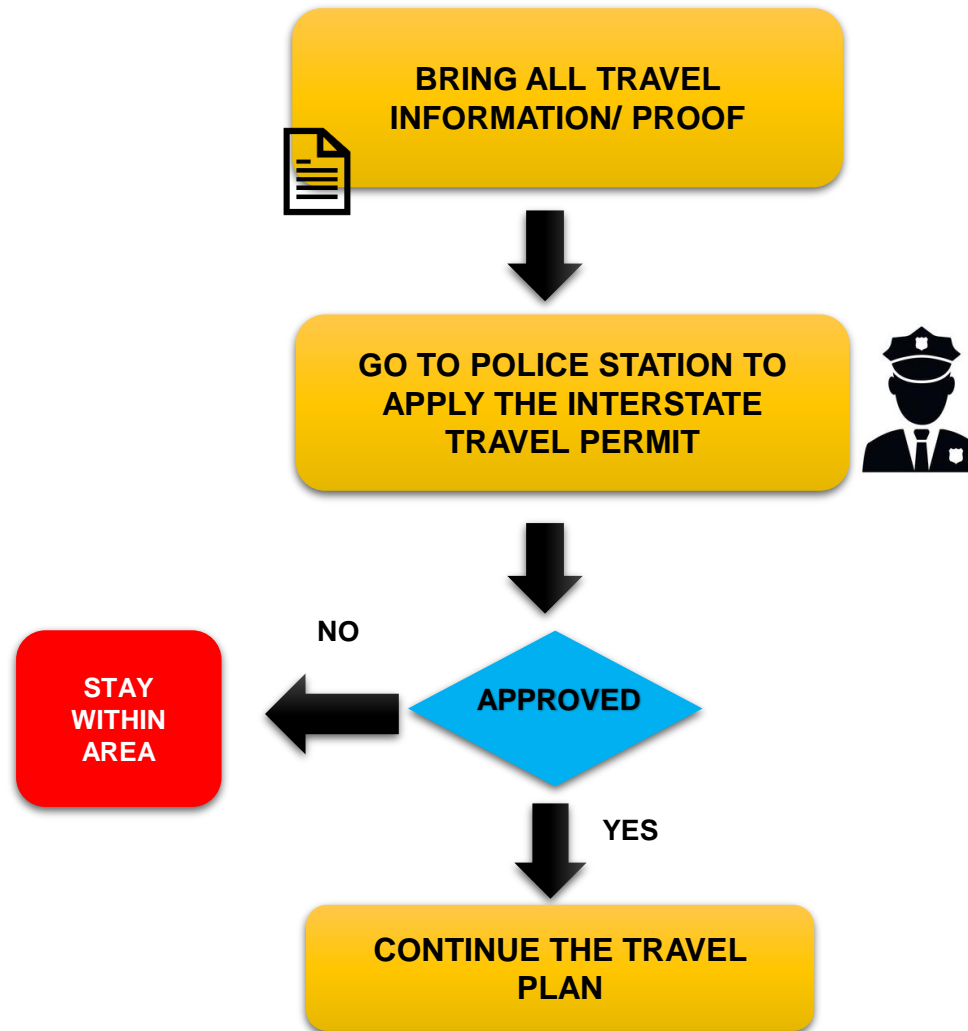
